**Initiatives in Place by BMTC:**

BMTC has been a pioneer in establishing standards for safe travel for women. It installed CCTV cameras in 500 buses and nine bus terminals and also introduced gender sensitization training to drivers and conductors. The corporation trained 15,401 employees and educated the crew about their responsibilities and duties and the measures to be taken in case of sexual harassment in buses. Segregation of seats for women is also in place with a fine of Rs.100 for non-adherence.
